
VBS 2015 Student /Youth Leader Registration Following Jesus Every Day – Passport to the Holy Land -June 15 -19,2015



This summer, St. Elizabeth Seton Religious Education is presenting the Vacation Bible School (VBS) program *Following Jesus Every Day- Passport to the Holy Land*. We will take our children on a tour that will show them the locations of the bible and daily life at the time of Christ. The five stops on our tour will be a carpenter shop in Nazareth, a marketplace in Jerusalem, a synagogue in Capernaum, the countryside of Bethlehem, and the home of Mary and Martha in Bethany. While on their visit, the children will become acquainted with people from Bible times who know Jesus or who could have been involved with him.

The children will all meet in the Great Hall from 9:00 - 9:50 and will be participating in music and a group activity under the direction of the Coordinators and Youth Leaders. They will then visit one of the rooms for two hours. At 11:50, the Youth Leaders will walk them back to the great Hall for a summary of the day's activities and dismissal by the Coordinators. On Friday, the lessons in the classrooms are shortened somewhat so the children can present a small program to their parents.

Please note the following requirements for registration.

- Registered parishioners will have precedence over non-parishioners.
- Registrations must be sent or dropped off at the RE office in a sealed envelope marked with VBS. If you are just registering for Youth Leaders only, please mark your envelope **VBS YOUTH Leader Only.** Please deposit your envelope in the box located on top of the counter outside the Religious Education office.
- Maximum number of children for each grade is 24. We may need to close a grade prior to end of registration and your child will be put on a waiting list. Some groups will be a combination of two grades.

Forms received after May 22 will be processed dependent on space available.

- If your child has special needs, we are more than willing to make special arrangements for your child. However, that needs to be stated on your registration form.
- Each family will be required to bring 1 gallon of juice per child (2 per family maximum) on the first day of VBS.
- The Youth Leader program is very popular and we will use the Lottery to decide on our Youth leaders if we have more than we can use. Youth Leader registration deadline will be May 22 and is open to young adults entering into grades 6 through 12. You will be notified whether you are in or not.
