Many of you with older children at All Saints may already be familiar with the 8<sup>th</sup> grade morphing project that I have coordinated over the past few years. This is a fun, but very time consuming, project that is a great keepsakes for the students and families. For those of you NOT familiar with it, it is a photo/video project that shows your child "morphing" from baby to 8<sup>th</sup> grader. It is presented to the students and families at the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Awards banquet the week before graduation. My youngest daughter is graduating from All Saints this year and I will not be involved in the project after this year. The software that is currently being used is not difficult to learn, but over the years I have accumulated a lot of knowledge and tips and tricks that need to be shared.

To streamline the process I have broken the project down into manageable tasks. Here is a list of volunteer opportunities, in order of time commitment and comfort level with technology.

**Morphing Coordinator and Lead Morpher** – (ideally can commit for 2-3 consecutive schools years and will train with me this year.) **Time commitment** will vary depending on how many volunteers there are and how big the 8<sup>th</sup> grade class is.

## Tasks include:

- Communicate with 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents at the beginning of the school year
- Managing schedule of other team members
- Review work of assistants and "tweak" if necessary
- Use the PC based morphing software to complete a group of designated "morphs"
- Create final DVD and coordinate creation of individual family dvds
- Train new coordinator and assistants when needed
- Secure other parents to assist with below tasks

**Assistant Morpher and or Photo Editor** (ideally can commit 2 consecutive years to the project) **Time commitment** averages 30-60 minutes per assigned student. This task can be split into only a photo editor or only an assistant morpher

## Tasks include:

- Edit and prepare photos for the morphing program. Must be comfortable using photo editing software such as Photoshop. (Training will be provided.)
- Complete assigned morphs using the PC based morphing software; number of assigned morphs will depend on how many others volunteer. (Training will be provided.)

Photo Collectors – no software use is needed, except possibly using a standalone photo scanner in the school office

## Tasks include:

- Responsible for securing photos from assigned group of parents.
- Pick up parent supplied CDs or flash drives in the school office when they become available
- Ensure the photos meet the guidelines and contact parents if needed
- Return flash drives to parents once they have been approved by morphers
